- Approval of minutes of 4 with one abstaining
- Visiting Speaker Parker Gasset - Community Resilience Marine Extension Associate, Maine Sea Grant (MSG)
 - MSG started in 2019 conveying public works directors, conservation committees and town managers around hazard mitigation, flood resilience, shoreline zoning
 - Rockland, Camden and Isleboro have already started these projects
 - Camden has used students to map impervious surfaces and create slr story maps as capstone projects

 - Camden has also worked on green infrastructure and storm water system mapping with UNH
