

Town of Rockport
Ordinance Limiting Home Cultivation of Marijuana for Personal Adult Use

Whereas the Town of Rockport deems it in the best interest of its citizens to limit the cultivation of marijuana for personal adult use with the Town, without affecting cultivation, use or distribution of Medical Marijuana as allowed by 22 MRS, Chapter 558-C.

Now there the Town of Rockport does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Title – Legislative Authority

This Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the Marijuana legalization Act 28-B MRS, Section 1502 Municipal Home Rule Authority, Maine Constitution Article VIII, Part 2, and 30-A MRS, Section 3001.

Section 2. Limitation of Home Cultivation

A. Home cultivation of marijuana for personal adult use by a person 21 years of age or older is limited to cultivation of three mature marijuana plants, twelve immature marijuana plants and an unlimited number of seedlings by each person 21 years of age or older who is domiciled on a parcel or tract of land, pursuant to 28-B MRS, Section 1502. No person shall be permitted to cultivate marijuana plants or seedlings on a parcel or tract of land on which he or she is not domiciled. Nothing in this Ordinance is intended to prohibit the lawful cultivation, use possession, or conduct pursuant to the Maine Medical use of Marijuana Act 22, MRS, Section 2421-2430-

Section 3. Effective Date: Duration

A. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon enactment by the Town of Rockport unless otherwise provided and shall remain in effect until it is amended or repealed.

Section 4. Enforcement Violations and Penalties

A. This Ordinance shall be enforced by the municipal officers or their designee. Violation of this Ordinance shall be subject to the enforcement and penalty provisions 30-A MRS, Section 4452.
